The Science 2022 Top Employers Survey polled employees in biotechnology, biopharmaceutical, pharmaceutical and related industries to determine the 20 best employers as well as the employers' driving characteristics. The findings are based on more than 6,200 completed surveys from readers of Science and other survey invitees. Survey respondents came from North America (63%), Europe (15%), Asia/Pacific Rim (17%) and other locations (5%).

About Newsweek Top 100 Most Loved Workplaces®

The Top 100 Most Loved Workplaces® are the result of a collaboration between *Newsweek* and the Best Practice Institute (BPI), a leadership development and benchmark research company. The results were determined after surveying more than 1.4 million employees from businesses with workforces varying in size from 50 to more than 10,000. The list recognizes companies that put respect, caring and appreciation for their employees at the center of their business model and, in doing so, have earned the loyalty and respect of the people who work for them.

To identify the top 100 companies for the *Newsweek* ranking, companies were evaluated and scored as follows: 35% of the initial score was based on employee survey responses; 25% was derived from analysis of external public ratings from sites such as Comparably, Careerbliss, Glassdoor, Indeed and Google; and 40% came from direct interviews with and written responses from company officials. *Newsweek* then conducted additional research into every company on the list, as well as the top runners up, to determine the final list of 100 companies and their ranking.
